

REPORT ON **CAREER COUNCIL ACTIVITIES**

The college is not having separate Career Counseling Cell. The IQAC of the college organizes occasional career-related programs for the students.

Following is a list of some Career awareness programs organized by the college during last five years:

Year: 2012

KNOWLEDGE FAIR:

1. A total of 20 students from Commerce stream were sent to participate in a KNOWLEDGE FAIR organized by District Industries & Commerce Centre, Tinsukia, in collaboration with National Chamber of Commerce. The two –day fair was held on 18th and 19th January, 2012, at Udyog Nagar, Tinsukia, where students, unemployed and self-employed youths, man and women of different areas of the district were educated and trained about Entrepreneurship Skills, Govt. Schemes for financial and technical assistances for establishment of small and cottage industrial units, business firms etc.

2. Three awareness programs on Career Guidance were organized by the college on 9th February, 24th March and 31st March, 2012 for students of Commerce Stream of the college. Mr. Sayan Chakraborty, a Professional Career Guide served as Resource person during these three days.

Year: 2013

1. On 26th March, 2013, 33 numbers of students were sent to Kaziranga University, Assam who participated in a Power-point and Video Counseling Program on “To Be or Not To Be”. The students were taught on Motivational and Attitudinal Changes required for establishing themselves.
2. Institute of Cost & Management Accountants, Kolkata Zone conducted a Counseling Programs on Importance and Opportunities of CMA Professionals. Ms. Ankita Ray, Academic Counselor, Kolkata Zone of ICAI, ADDRESSED ONE HUNDRED Commerce Students of the college on 22nd August, 2013.

Year: 2014

1. Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship, Guwahati was invited by the college on 5th and 6th March, 2014 which organized a Two-Day Training Program for the students of the college. Mr. Pranab Sharma and Mr. Hemanta Rabha, Program

Officer and Research Officer of the IIE, Guwahati, delivered lectures, presentations, etc. on various entrepreneurial skills required for becoming successful entrepreneurs. They focused on qualities such as Leadership, Risk taking, Organizing, Team Spirit, Technical Training etc. One hundred student participants were given Certificates by the IIE at the end of the program.

2. A total of 7 students of the college were sent to ACE College, Tinsukia on 12th December, 2014, who participated in a Counseling Program of various professional courses for Commerce students. Resource persons like Dr. M.J. Sharma (CMS, Dibrugarh University), Mr. Rakesh Agarwal (ex-Secretary, Tinsukia Chamber of Commerce) and one executive from ICICI Bank delivered and presented talks on career opportunities available for UG students and on necessary preparatory exercises.
3. Prof. Shantanu Bora, a SEBI authorized expert (Resource Person) was invited to college by the College IQAC on 26th February, 2014 who delivered lecture and presentation on “Financial Planning for Young Investors”. 75 students from UG Commerce stream part in the program.

Year ; 2015

1. Institute of Cost & Management Accountants of India (ICAI) Kolkata Zone conducted a Counseling cum Awareness Program for Commerce students of the college on 10th February, 2015. Ms. Ankita Ray, Course Counselor, Ms. Priyanka Dey and Mr. Tarun Roy delivered speech and presentation on “Cost & Management Accountancy as a Profession in modern Business and Industrial World. The experts explained the procedure, Course Curriculum, Eligibility Criteria for studying CMA. Fifty six Commerce students of the college took part in the program. And received Certificates from the ICAI.
2. Indian Air Force, Chabua conducted a Counseling Program for the students of the college, under their “AIF Publicity & Awareness Drive, on 20th February, 2015 the program” started at 11 a.m. at college auditorium in presence of about 50 students.
3. Ten numbers of students went to participate in a National Workshop on Entrepreneurship at Women’s College, Tinsukia on 13th and 14th February, 2015. The program was organized by the inviting college in collaboration with RAJIV GANDHI NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF YOUTH DEVELOPMENT.
4. The ICAI, Kolkata came again and conducted another CMA Awareness Program for students of the college on 28th August, 2015. Ms. Ankita Ray and Mr. Shankar Mazumder (noted Career professional) discussed appealed the students for coming up to take CMA as a career choice. More than one hundred students participated in the one day program.

Year: 2016

- 1. A free Coaching for Competitive Examinations (SSC, APSC, UPSC, Banking Service etc.) was started on 7th February, 2017.
