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About Tinsukia Commerce College:

In half a century old existence, the college has grown into a multi-disciplinary institution having diverse professional, technical and arts programme from higher secondary to masters. Having completed 50 years of our golden period, in 2022, Tinsukia Commerce College – its constituents; we, are a family of some stakeholders – students at Higher Secondary, Undergraduate and Post Graduate levels in commerce and allied areas, some members, faculty and administrative, staff, parents and guardians and GB Members.

A College of Commerce in Tinsukia was thought of, in the year 1971 by some members of the Governing Body of Tinsukia College. An Ad-hoc Committee was constituted in 1972 with Late J. N. Bhuyan as President, and Late B. K. Saraswat as Secretary. The Committee decided to start the college under the name of Tinsukia Commerce College from the session 1972. Late Krishna Pada Dutta Chowdhury took the charge of the college as Honorary Principal. Perhaps he considered it prudent to accept the post with the idea of spreading and meeting the aspiration of students for commerce education in this remote corner of the state when there was no commerce college in its vicinity of the then Tinsukia Sub-division. The management of Senairam H.S School was kind enough to allow us to hold classes in its building. Thus, Tinsukia Commerce College was established on 21st August 1972 in Senairam H.S School with no fund and building.

In 1977, the Govt. of Assam was pleased to allot 35 bighas of land, which is now under the possession of the college,. On 01.02.1986, the college was taken over by the Govt. of Assam under Deficit Grant-in-Aid. Thereby, with effect from December, 2005 it has become a provincialized college under the Govt. of Assam.

Considering the demand of the society and neighbouring students we considered it prudent to introduce B.A. from the session 2011-12 under Dibrugarh University on self financing system. Apart from the regular mode of courses. we have also been offering M.B.A., M.A., M.Sc. (Math), B.C.A., B.A., B.Com. and various PG degree, diploma and certificate courses under KKHSOU, DODL-DU and ASOS for the last few years. Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Assam, has announced Science Stream in our college and degree courses for science, like B.Sc. have been proposed under Dibrugarh University by Govt. of Assam and soon will be functioning.

The college facilitates the students with – a well-equipped Football Ground, safe drinking water, canteen, generator facility, cycle stand, library with reading and internet facility, digitalized classroom and teaching, computer education, computer lab., health building instruments, day care, community centre, equal opportunity centre, boys' and Girls' common room, sports goods with gym facilities, educative programmes and a pollution-free campus. Our college has also been declared ***Khelo India Small Centre*** for football by Director of Sports and Welfare, Govt, of Assam in the year 2021.

Several MoUs have been signed with Institutions like ***Skillfinity, Gauhati; ICT Academy***, Chennai; K.C. Das Commerce College; ***Tool Room & Training Centre***; Sripuria Football Academy; ***Bosch India Academia-Industry Partnership***; ***Career Mentor Educare & Training Pvt. (CMET)***, Maharastra; Assam Electronics Development Corporation Ltd. (***AMTRON***) and ***Bir Raghav Moran College***. The college has also received ***“One District, One Green Champions’ Award*** in 2021-2022, under Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education. The college had undergone 2nd cycle of

NAAC assessment on 28th and 29th March 2017. The Peer team assessed all the academic and non-academic aspects of the college and finally the college was accredited **Grade 'B'**.

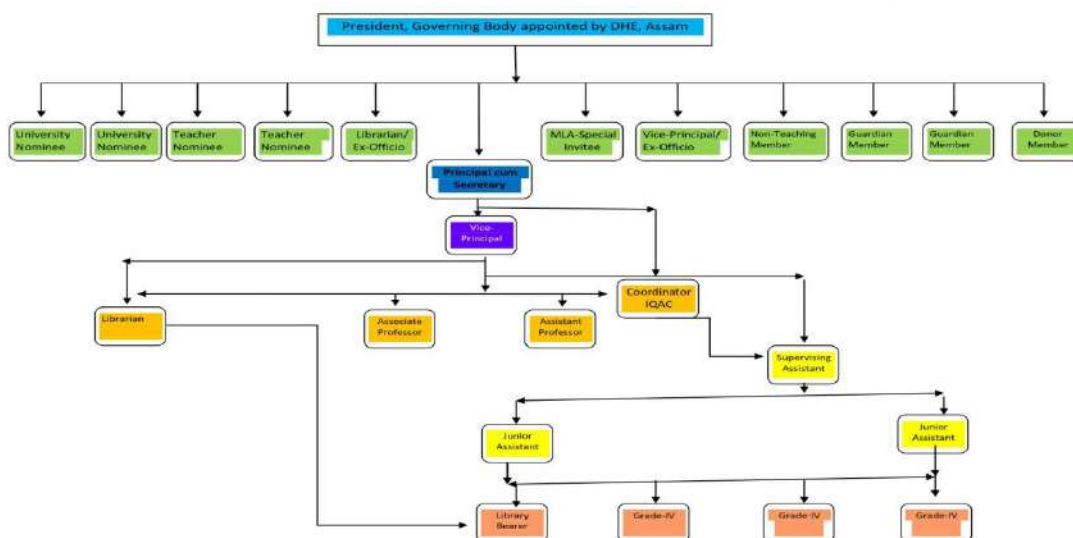

Infrastructure:

The college spreads over an area of 11.33 acres of land within a serene atmosphere pleasant landscape. The atmosphere is less polluted with full of greenery and nice plantation with valuables trees. The infrastructure of the college is well supported for the teaching-learning activities of the Colleges. Some notable highlight of the available infrastructure and learning resources are mentioned as below.

Major infrastructural facilities are also available in the college. It includes:

- (ii) Teaching blocks with adequate number class rooms
- (iii) Rest-room facilities for students
- (iv) Adequate numbers of drinking water facilities

The faculty members under the able leadership of the principal of the college actively participated to ensure operation and proper maintenance of the available infrastructure facilities.

There are two income generating activities are also available in the college campus. These are vermi-composting and seasonal farming. These activities can be exemplified as doing-learning (activity-based learning) for the learners. In addition to fulfilling the sports requirements of the students of the college, the uses of the sports facilities are also extended to neighbouring outsiders and sport associations.

Computer facilities are also made available to the faculties for various academic activities. Short computer training courses are also used to generate lump sum revenue for the college.

The college keeps provision for annual maintenance contracts with various vendors for the maintenance of IT infrastructure, physical facilities, electrification and water purification.

The college library is well maintained with a total number of 10843 text and 1863 reference books. Apart from this, journals and periodicals (32), e-journals (10) and CDs (37) are there. It is managed by the competent manpower and updated standard management and supervision system. The library system is automated with SOUL 3.0 software. It has e-resources from Sage Publication and Nlist.

The college is also keen to update the available software regularly and protect by using anti-virus software. There are 43 rooms in total. Out of which, 17 class rooms, 02 Computer laboratory/digital rooms, 01 seminar room which are well furnished with dual desks and green

boards, TVs, smart penal, etc. The college campus has free wi-fi connection and internet facility to access e-books and journals. The library is automated with SOUL 3.0 software developed by INFLIBNET. All the Computer laboratories have internet connection and wi-fi facilities. The examination office of the college is equipped with internet, xerox, scanner and printing facilities.

The College has 16 stationed multi-gymnasiums, store room; good play ground for outdoor sports and games with basket ball court along with an auditorium to conduct cultural activities, indoor games and yoga training center.

In total, the college has 62 computers, 11 laptops out of which 52 computers are available for the use of students. There are 02 LCD projectors and 03 smart panels and 08 audio-visual facilities for ICT teaching in the college.

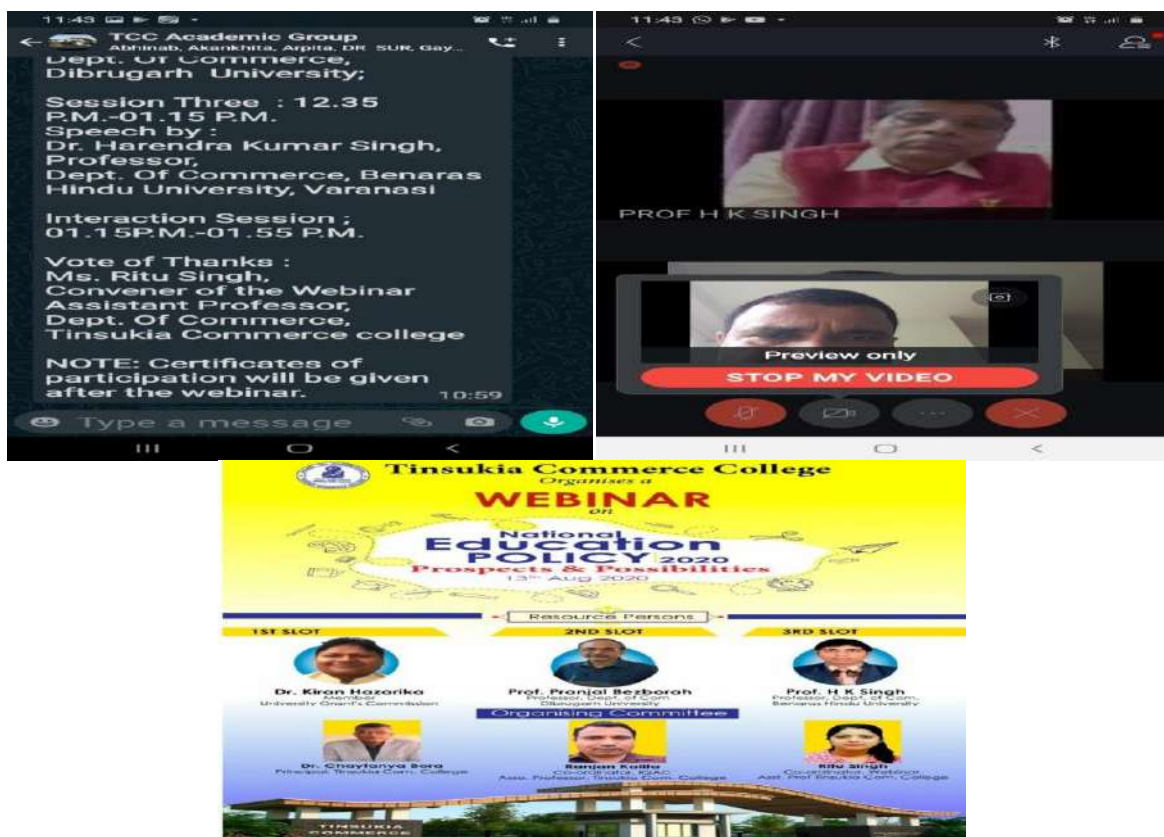
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National Webinar on "National Education Policy 2020-Prospects and Possibilities"

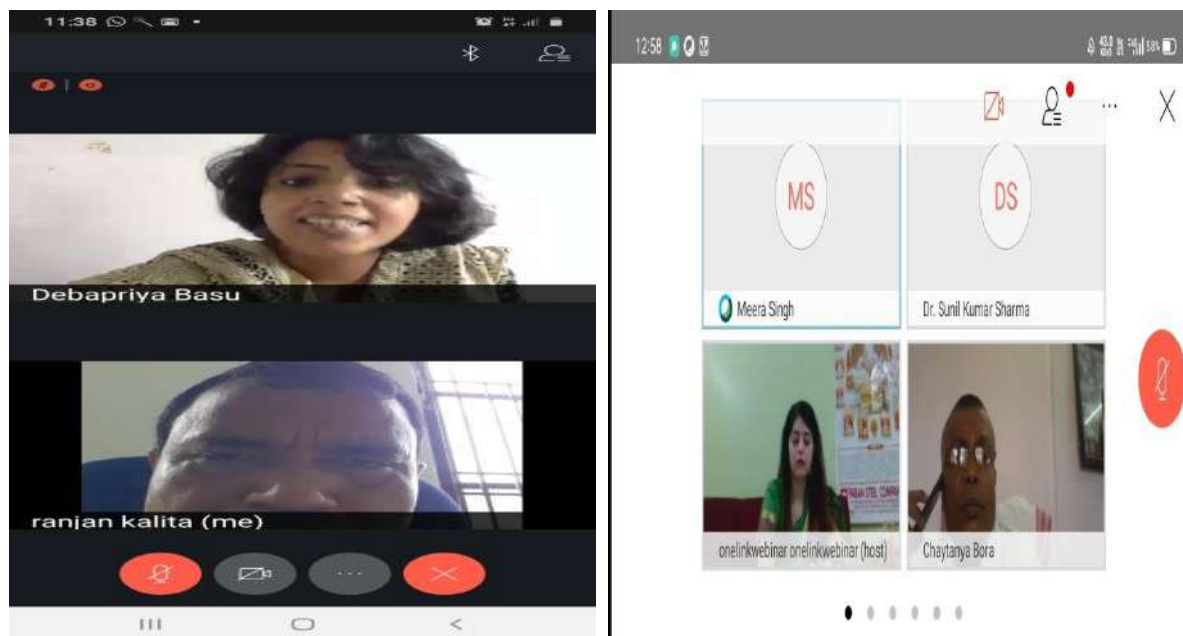


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National Webinar on Literature & Technology

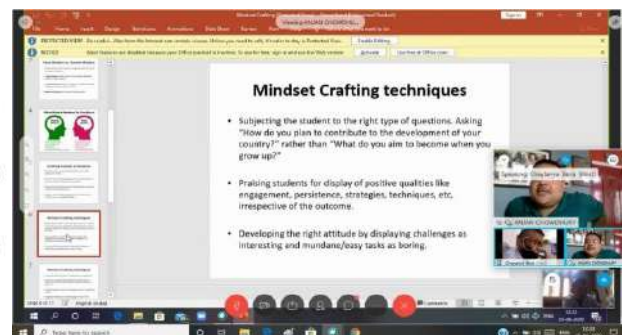

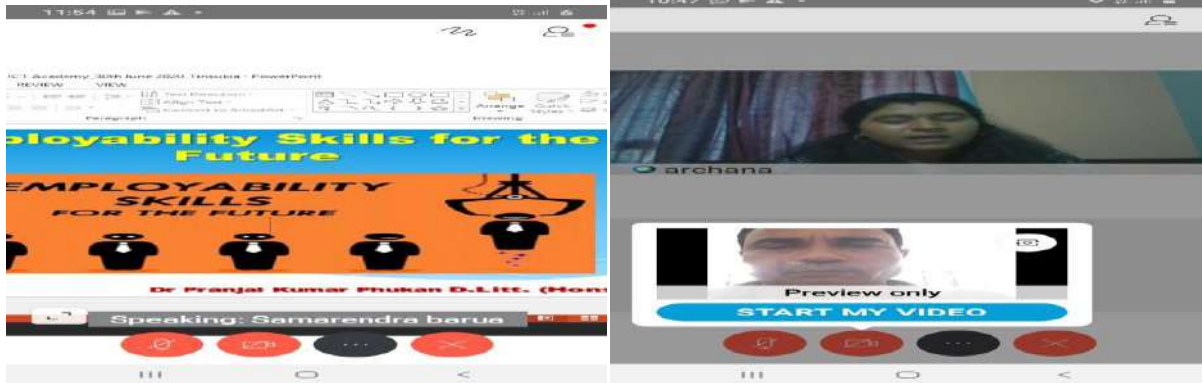

Best Practices of the College:

Best Practices-I Go green:

Title: Go green – is a concept to create awareness on organic culture.

Objectives: Produce fertilizer through vermi composting, use the degradable wastages, training to the students, generation of revenue.

Context: We have collected organic waste from TMA and organic waste generated in the college campus. Further, using Worms-Red Wrangler convert waste into organic fertilizer. Two composting pits are developed. Process will take 3-4 months. Students are trained and certified.

Evidence of success: Collecting materials from the TMB. Fertilizers are sold. Revenue is generated and used for campus cleaning, trained 100 students.

Problems: Shortage of staff, transportation facility, few students are interested.

Best Practice-II:

Title: Football coaching to the students

Objective: Optimum utilization of sports facility, create awareness, make students physically fit, utilize the leisure time of students.

Context: Assam Govt. granted fund to upgrade ground. MoU signed with Sripuria Football Academy for Football Training.

Evidence of success: College is granted small Khelo India centre by the Director, Sports and Youth Welfare, Government of Assam. Some of the students are selected by Minerva Academy, NRL, Tulip, SAI.

Problems: To manage students below the age group of 10 years. Coaching cannot be continued for long period.
